“Local Companies Take Part in Expansion Project”

To further enhance their position as a leading equipment supplier in industrial process markets, R-V Industries, Inc. of Honey Brook, PA, has started construction on a 26,000 square foot facility expansion. The expansion, scheduled for completion in September, will provide additional shop floor space dedicated to stainless steel and high nickel alloy metals used in the food and beverage, pharmaceutical, nuclear, and critical process industries. The facility will increase R-V’s capacity to manufacture high end equipment while avoiding cross contamination of materials.

Several local companies have been chosen to take part in R-V’s expansion project.

Risbon Excavating, located on Poplar Road in Honey Brook, PA, is executing the excavation and was also contracted to complete the public sewer connection required for the new facility. The project has helped with Risbon’s efforts to expand into commercial excavation services.

Hoover Buildings, located on the Horseshoe Pike in Honey Brook, is contracted to pour the foundation, install the metal structure, complete the siding and roof work.

Kone Cranes have been contracted to supply overhead cranes giving R-V 50 tons of lifting capacity with 30 feet of clearance under the hook.

Other contractors include: G.A. Vietri Inc. of Coatesville to install the electrical, Titus Company of New Morgan for pneumatic system install, and C&W Mechanical of Pottstown to complete the mechanical components involved in this project.

Once the facility expansion is complete, R-V’s current 62,000 square foot, 14 acre, satellite facility in Wagontown, PA, which includes overhead cranes, machining, mechanical assembly, fabrication and office space will be consolidated to R-V’s corporate headquarters in Honey Brook.
